

Glossop High Peak Sharks:

December 2011:

Three Glossop swimmers travelled to the North East Regional Swimming Event in Durham. Thomas Hand won top boy for his age group on disability points. Ellie Bamber won Gold medals in the 50m & 100m Backstroke and a Silver medal in the 50m Breaststroke. Jasmine Bamber, Ellie's younger sister also competed at the event.

Ellie's success at the event meant she achieved an IPC (International Paralympic Classification) for Breaststroke, which means she can now compete in this event at International swimming events.

January 2012:

Five Glossop swimmers travelled to the South East Regional Championships. The team consisted of Ellie and Jasmine Bamber, Thomas and Sophie Hand and Sebastian Southwell. No medals were given out at this event, but all swimmers achieved a number of excellent personal best's with Ellie recording the fastest ladies backstroke time for the whole event.

March 2012:

Martha Boulton and Ellie Bamber travelled to the DSE National Championships. Unfortunately, no other Glossop swimmers were eligible to swim at this event due to changes in classification regulations.

In the S14 Group B category, Martha finished third in both the 100m freestyle and 100m breaststroke. Ellie swimming under her new SB9 Group B classification finished fourth in 100m breaststroke. Ellie also swam as part of the North West Region medley relay team, in which the team took the overall Gold medal.

April 2012:

Ellie Bamber travelled to the British International Swimming Championships. The Championships, were being used as the second round of the British Swimming teams Paralympic selection. Ellie finished 18th overall in the under 16 year old, 100m breaststroke, and finished 54th overall in the ladies 100m breaststroke.

Nearer to home Ellie also won tremendous teenager in the 2012 New Mills Town Honours awards.
